## What is the Community Access Program (CAP)?

The Community Access Program (CAP) offers free computer and high-speed internet access to the public for people who do not have regular access to them. As well, one on one training and workshops are provided on various computer topics. The fully equipped computer lab is operated from 8:30-4:30, in which there are no time restrictions.



All people in a community, whether they be vision or hearing impaired, physically challenged, families with young children, elderly persons, those using temporary mobility aids (such as crutches), or anyone otherwise requiring assistance, have full access to a CAP location, and are able to participate in the opportunities and programs CAP provides.
