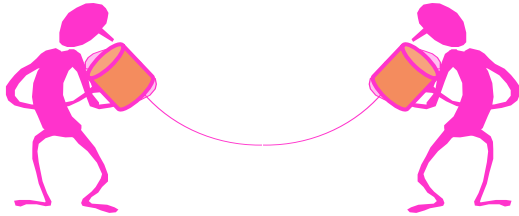


Communications

The Program

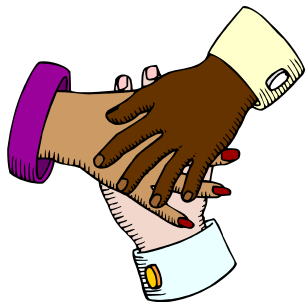
“What’s Cooking?” is a one year Job Creation Partnership funded by the Government of Canada and administered by the Kiwanis Enterprise Centre.

“What’s Cooking?” Participants learn new job skills and gain experience by working towards several community enhancement projects.

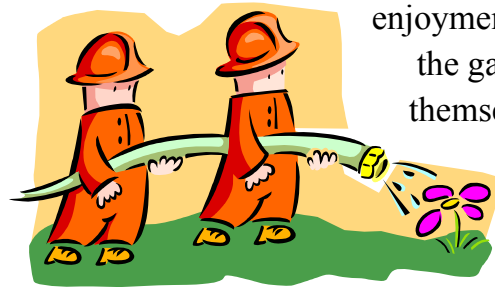
The Partners

Community Gardens

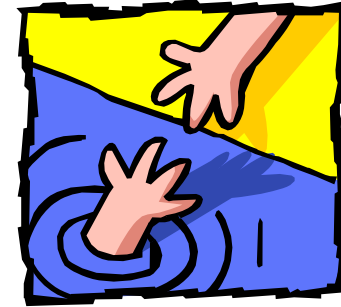
Participants will assist community gardeners to organize and to access information, services and opportunities that will benefit the community, maximize the efficiency and effectiveness of the gardens and enhance the
